• Check your bank account and credit card statements for unauthorized charges or for any purchases you didn't make.

• Don't give out personal information over the phone, especially if you're not sure who is on the other end of the line.

• Avoid giving money or gift cards to people who knock on your door or call you on the phone asking for help.

• Be wary of email attachments from unknown senders, especially if they include links to websites that want you to enter personal information like your name, address, Social Security number and date of birth.
