In our network of 78 lane miles of streets, Public Works has been effective in its approach to ongoing maintenance of streets, sidewalks, and traffic control systems. Most recent efforts such as the introduction of a four-way stop, pavement enhancement and improvement, and graffiti abatement have been at the forefront of city priorities and made possible by way of approved budget and funding.
