RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF SAN DIEGO OPTING OUT OF THE REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 9170(A) OF THE CALIFORNIA ELECTIONS CODE REGARDING BALLOT LABELS

**WHEREAS**, Assembly Bill 1416 (AB 1416), passed in 2022, requires all ballot labels for state measure to include the same list of proponents and opponents that is printed in the voter information guide; and

WHEREAS, duplication of this information causes significant space concerns on the ballot, leading to increased design, printing and postage costs; and

**WHEREAS**, San Diego County's voter information pamphlet contains all information pertaining to local ballot measures; and

**WHEREAS**, counties are permitted to opt-out of duplicating the proponent and opponent information for local measures onto the ballots;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED** that having found that the duplication of local measure information is unnecessary and causes undue burdens and costs to be placed on County taxpayers, the County of San Diego will opt-out of the AB 1416 requirements under California Elections Code Section 9170(d).
