REPAIRING AN AGING INFRASTRUCTURE

SALES TAX 2024

emon Grove's City Council has placed a one-cent sales tax increase on the November 5, 2024, Statewide General Election Ballot.

If this measure is approved by voters, it will significantly improve infrastructure and essential city services. The proposed increase would bring the sales tax rate to 8.75%.

Certain items like groceries, medicine, and other essential products are exempt by law from this tax, reducing the impact on residents with fixed incomes.

The proposed tax is expected to generate approximately \$5.96 million annually. This flexible funding would be tailored to address specific community needs, leading to a higher quality of life for Lemon Grove residents.

Investing in the City's infrastructure will have a significant positive impact on economic growth. The one-cent sales tax is uniquely poised to prioritize repairs for aging infrastructure such as storm drains, roads, parks, and community facilities ensuring that our community thrives with improved services and a stronger infrastructure.

PROJECT TIMELIN



The City of Lemon Grove received approximately \$4 million in funding Connect Main Street aims to create a community corridor that supports active lifestyles and transportation choices.

The project is split into seven (7) phases. Construction for Phases 1-2, and 3 are underway.

September 3-6 (Phase 1 & 2)

- Set-up traffic control for closure of Central Ave
- Demo asphalt of railroad crossing
- Prepare subgrade for asphalt, curb, gutter, and sidewalk
- Form curb and gutter at Lemon Grove Ave. and Main Street

September 9-13 (Phase 1 & 2)

- Form curb and gutter at Lemon Grove Ave. and Main Street
- Pour curb and gutter at Lemon Grove Ave. and Main Street
- Form sidewalk and pedestrian ramp at Lemon Grove Ave. and Main Street

September 16-20 (Phase 1 & 2)

- Form sidewalk and pedestrian ramp at Lemon Grove and Main Street
- Pour sidewalk at Lemon Grove Ave. and Main Street
- Pave asphalt at Lemon Grove Ave. and Main Street crossing
- Continue grading subgrade for DG and asphalt (Phase 3)
