


Community Connect

Project Green Light Detroit

Challenge

Reduce crime and make citizens feel safe at night.

Solution

Initial focus on gas stations open past 10pm. Out-of-the-box integration of Stratocast for a cost effective way of connecting various small businesses to Detroit PD. No custom integration work.

Results

Violent Crime at Participating Locations Down 30-50%

Car Jackings down almost 50% in 2 years


Increase in Revenue at sites 40-60%

Integration to 911 Dispatch-Real Time Video

Increased Dialogue in Community and Business Owners

Communication: Command Layer down to the Neighborhood Patrol Officer
