A PLAN OF ACTION TO ADDRESSHOMELESSNESS

The Regional Task Force on Homelessness (RTFH), in partnership with the City of Lemon Grove, held a press conference on March 3, 2025, to announce the award of an \$8.4 million Encampment Resolution Funding (ERF) grant. This grant, which will be distributed over two years, is designed to address homelessness along the California State Route 94 corridor. By utilizing a "by-name" list, the funding will support rapid rehousing efforts for individuals currently experiencing homelessness in the area.



The grant will directly support the rehousing of 102 individuals who have been living unsheltered along the corridor. Approximately 85% of the grant will be allocated toward rental subsidies, intensive case management, landlord engagement, and housing retention services, all aimed at helping these individuals successfully transition into stable housing outcomes. Additionally, the funds will support essential outreach efforts, project management, and other supportive services to ensure long-term housing stability.

The 2024 Point In Time Count highlights that nearly 45% of individuals experiencing homelessness along the SR 94 corridor are chronically homeless and face significant barriers to accessing critical services such as healthcare, transportation, and housing. City Manager Lydia Romero expressed her enthusiasm for the collaborative effort, saying: "This is an exciting and unprecedented collaboration between RTFH, the City of Lemon Grove, and the State of California. I am optimistic and hopeful as we finally bring the much-needed and welcomed resources to our unhoused community members."

This grant represents a critical step forward in addressing homelessness in Lemon Grove and the region by providing the necessary resources to make a lasting impact on the lives of those in need.

The City of Lemon Grove is underway with the Street Rehabilitation Project. Construction will include street repair and rehab on 72 segments of streets. Crews will be performing a variety of tasks, including asphalt removal, installation of new asphalt, repairs to the asphalt base, construction of ADA-compliant ramps, and the removal and replacement of road striping. These activities may cause temporary lane closures or shifts in traffic patterns, so it is important to plan your routes in advance and allow for extra travel time. Please stay alert and follow all posted traffic control measures to ensure safety for both workers and motorists. This project is part of our ongoing effort to beautify city streets and improve the driving experience for residents and visitors alike.
